Safety Training 101 by Indivisible East Bay

Sunday December 14 2pm-4:30pm in Connie Barbour Room

BFUU members who are interested in joining a protest safety team are welcome to attend our "Safety Training 101". Protest Safety Teams, sometimes known as "Peace Ambassadors," "Peacekeepers," or "Marshalls," play an important role in maintaining nonviolence, keeping protestors safe, and ensuring the success of actions. This training is intended for new Safety Team members or existing members who want to develop their skills. It is also open to anyone in our sister organizations who would like to join a Safety Team.

At this in-person training we will cover goals, roles and responsibilities, communications, deescalation skills, and an introduction to traffic management at protests. Much of the training will be devoted to role plays of de-escalation scenarios.

Indivisible East Bay is committed to nonviolent social change, and we believe our power comes from courage, organization, community and discipline.
